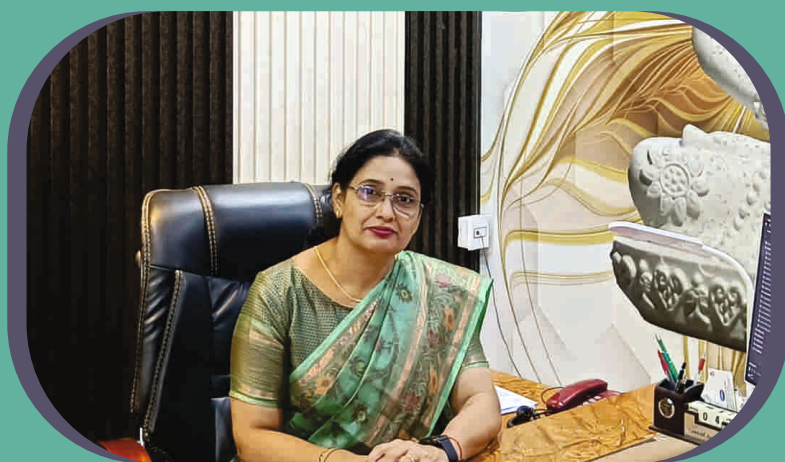

Prior to 1962, the Kothari commission felt the need of such senior secondary schools in the country so as to follow common syllabus and pattern throughout India and to be affiliated to an All-India-Body, for the benefit of the children of Central Government employees as well as floating population of the country. In November 1964, on the basis of the report of the Kothari Commission, the Government of India, were pleased to open a number of senior secondary schools at various places of the country so as to render educational facilities to the children of such floating families.

ADMISSION

The admission to the school is at entry level points of the Pre-Primary and the Lower Primary Wing (Nursery/LKG/UKG/Class I)

Admission to the rest of the classes is dependent on seat availability and vacancy status for the academic session.

Note : Mere registration does not guarantee admission. Admission will be granted strictly on the basis of Admission Test and interactions.

Age (on 1st April of the year of admission)

Nursery : 3 Years

LKG : 4 Years

UKG : 5 Years

Class I : 6 Years



Process

Admission for Pre-Primary is based on weightage of categories (such as neighbourhood, sibling, girl child, alumni, single parent & school specific paraments) along with short interactions with the School Team. Admission to other classes include assessment of general aptitude with psychometric evaluations.

Enclosures

1. Birth Certificate only for Nursery, Kindergarten.
2. Transfer Certificate from the school last attended (From class UKG).
3. Photocopy of Progress Report (from Class LKG onwards) of the previous classes.
4. Aadhaar Card (Child and both parents).
5. Child ID
6. PEN (Permanent Education No.) & APAAR ID of the Child (from Class LKG onwards).
7. Immunization/Health record of the student.
8. Bank Details of the parents will the photocopy of Passbook and Aadhaar card linked with that Bank.
9. Passport size coloured photograph.
10. Self attested photocopy & Caste and income certificate (for the students of OBC/SC/ST only).

The following enclosures should compulsorily be attached with the Registration Form. If any of these is not available, an application for extension must be made. In any case the required documents should be submitted within fifteen days of the admission.

Withdrawal and Refund

A parent desiring withdrawal of his/her ward from the school will have to give one month notice in writing or one term fee in lieu thereof. A transfer certificate will be issued only when dues if any, are cleared and the withdrawal notice has been received in writing.

Course and Affiliation

It follows the All India syllabus approved and prescribed by the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi, the leading of All India Secondary Examination Body. The Schools which are having classes from Nursery to XII (+2) are made affiliated to the CBSE under All India Education scheme.

Fee Rules

1. The fee will be collected upto 15th of every month; if 15th falls on a holiday, the next working day will be the last day for collecting the fee without imposing any late fee.
2. The last date of depositing the tuition fee will be 15th of every month, after which late fee will be charged as per following:-
 - From 16th to last day of the month- Rs. 20/-
 - Next each month onwards- Rs.50/ month
3. Once fees deposited will not be refunded.
4. If a student seeks to leave school for whatever reason, the withdrawal notice, at least a month in advance, will have to be submitted, falling which he will be required to deposit one month's tuition fee & other relevant fees.
5. The fee for the month of May and June will have to be deposited in the month of December and January. The admission fee will be charged in the month of April as the school session starts from 1st April to 31st March every academic year.

Syllabus and Booklist from class NURSERY to XII are available in the school website, and Syllabus is also printed in student diary.

Rules & Regulation for the Students

To maintain strict discipline, to speed up progress and streamline efficiency, we are compelled to take certain precautionary measures in the institution and their compliance is compulsory. Any failure to do so, may necessitate disciplinary action without prior notice.

1. Disturbances like running, shouting etc. during class hours are not allowed in the school. Games & sports are to be played during the time fixed for it.
2. Students must respect all teachers and authorities. They must be courteous and polite under all circumstances.
3. Any damage to the school property or to the belongings of the staff or any other student will have to be compensated for.
4. Students must observe punctuality in arriving at school. A late-comer may not be allowed to enter the school or class. Continuous late-comers would be suspended.
5. All the students must come neatly dressed to the school. During regular checking any student found without proper uniform shall be punished.
6. Under no circumstances the school authorities will be held liable for indiscipline or misconduct on the part of any students outside the school premises.
7. The minimum compulsory attendance in class as follows: Nursery to XII- 75 percentage Student falling short of attendance, as prescribed above, will not be allowed to appear for the examination.
8. A student who has been absent on the previous day without leave application will not be permitted to the class unless permission is granted by the Principal/ Head Mistress. One who remains - absent without leave application for 20 days will be expelled from the school. A student who remains absent due to illness for a considerable span of time must submit a medical certificate. Absence without leave application from parents will be penalized with a fine of Rs. 5 each day.
9. Any mis-demeanour during the examination will amount to failure in subject & will be dealt with stern disciplinary action.
10. The student must bring their textbooks, notebooks and school diary regularly to the class.
11. Parents/Guardians are expected to help their wards in their home assignments & check their school diary regularly.
12. As the medium of instruction in the school is English, it is compulsory for the students to converse in English.
13. No visitor will be allowed to contact any student without the prior permission of the office.
14. The student will not be called from the class to attend any phone call unless it is very urgent.
15. Participation in all school activities and function is compulsory and the school uniform is to be worn in such functions unless instructed otherwise.

ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES

The curriculum from Nursery to Std XII includes the following core subject and the following activities.

NURSERY : To develop motivation towards study in school environment, an introduction to the capital letters of alphabets in English, Hindi ¼Loj½ and Numbers 1 to 50, colouring.

KINDERGARTEN : Children learn to write the cursive alphabets in English & Hindi ¼Loj@;atu½] reading & writing of short words in both languages, Number 1 to 100, drawing.

STD I to V: English, Hindi, Maths, Environment Studies, Computer, Music, General Knowledge, SUPW, Drawing & Crafts. **STD VI to VII:** English, Hindi, Sanskrit, General Science, Modern Mathematics, Social Studies, Crafts, Drawing & Painting, Music, General Knowledge, SUPW, Computer Science and Mental Mathematics.

HPC for foundation stage (Nursery to Class II) : School has implemented HPC for foundation stage to ensure holistic development of students. HPC syllabus is designed as per NEP 2020 Guidelines that follows a play based, experimental and skill based learning approach.

STD IX & X: Compulsory subject: Hindi Course A, Communicative English, Mathematics, Science and technology and Social Science.

STD XI & XII (10+2) Pattern:

Science stream: Compulsory-English, Physics & Chemistry. Optional- Maths/Hindi, Biology/Physical Education (any two may be offered)

Commerce stream: Compulsory-English Core, Business Studies, Accountancy & Economics, Optional- Hindi/Physical Education/Maths (any one may be offered).

Test & Examination:

In each academic year the school will hold the following test and examinations.

1. Exam Scheme for Nursery L.K.G. & U.K.G.: The school academic year is planned out from April to March and is divided into three terms. At the end of the each term there will be Periodical Assessment i.e. Quarterly, Half yearly and Annual examination.

2. Exam Schemes from classes I to VIII: The school will conduct two terminal examinations in the entire year from class I to VIII. Periodic Assessment-I and Half Yearly Examination will be included with Term-I (April-September) and Periodic Assessment-II and Annual Examination will be included with Term-II (October-March). Class assessment and Project activity will also be included with each term.

3. Exam Schemes from classes XI and X: For class IX and X three periodic written tests will be conducted in the entire year and the average of best two will be taken for final mark submission.

4. Pre-Board examination: These examinations are conducted twice (Jan. & Feb.) for the students of classes X & XII. These examinations are based on complete syllabus of each subject. These examinations help the students to face the Board/Annual examination as well as to understand the system of the Board examination.

5. Board Examination: It is started from first week of March every year for the students of class XII and class X. It is confirmed that periodic exams are not applicable for classes XI & XII. For these classes Quarterly in the month of August, Half yearly in the month of October and Annual examination in the month of Feb./March are conducted.



ACADEMIC PROGRAMMES
